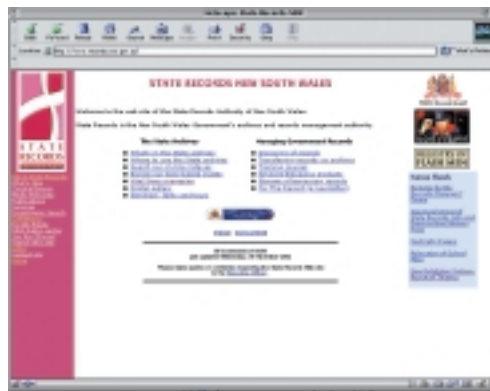


Home IMPROVEMENTS
