be so good as to make me (according
to my measure in your possession)
and send out to me to this
Country, by the very first
good opportunity that offers after your
receipt of this Letter, Six Pairs
of Hessian Half Boots; four
Pairs of which to be made
strong, and the remaining
two Pairs to be Dress ones.
After you have shipped

them, my Bankers Messrs
Coutts and Co of London, will
pay you the amount of your
Bill on presenting it.
